Principal's Report

P&C AGM. Thank you to those parents and friends who were able to attend the Annual General Meeting of the P&C. Paul Gellie was elected President and Grant Ryan was elected Secretary/Treasurer. Meetings of the P&C are open to both parents of students and community members. Meetings are set down for the Thursday afternoons of Weeks 5 and 10 each term commencing at 5pm.

Fees can be paid at the school office and membership details will be recorded, again this is for insurance purposes.


Teaching and Learning. This term our Connected Outcomes Group (COGs) unit is *Making Choices and Working Together*.

In HSIE the students have explored rights, responsibilities, and decision making processes as related to families, workers local councils and state and federal governments.

In Science our work has focused on Communication and how people keep in touch. We have already looked at a variety of historical ways to communicate as well as how communication has changed. The students designed their own symbol system and then wrote their names using the symbols they developed.

In English our focus has been visual texts. I have been trialling a unit of work from the New English Syllabus, to be introduced next year, called *Pictures Tell the Story*. The unit develops the students understanding of how stories can be communicated using images – both still images and moving images. Through an in-depth study of a wordless picture book and an animated short film we have explored how visual narratives are constructed. This week and next the students are experimenting with digital tools and processes to compose their own multimodal texts.

Possum Box. Last week the students put together a possum box kit we obtained from Thalgarrah Field Studies Centre. The purpose is to entice the possum to live in the box, rather than looking to return to the ceiling of the classroom. The students were very excited to screw together the box, paint and then have it placed into the pine tree near the hall.
