Vegie Fritters

Ingredients

- 1 Medium Zucchini 310g Can Sweet Corn
- 1 Small Carrot
- 1 Small Onion
- ¼ Cup Self-raising Flour
- ½ Teaspoon Cumin
- 3 Eggs separated

A Pinch cinnamon



Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 150°C
- 2. Grate Zucchini, carrot & onion into a large bowl with the drained corn, Add flour & cinnamon.
- 3. Stir Through egg yolks and season with pepper.
- 4. Whisk the egg whites until firm peaks form and gently folding through the egg yolk mixture.
- 5. Spray a large frying pan with oil and heat medium heat.
- 6. Place two tablespoons of the mixture into the pan and cook for two minutes on each side or until golden brown.
- 7. Remove the fritters from the pan and keep warm in the oven. Repeat the process with the remaining mixture.
- 8. Serve with tzatziki and salad.
